

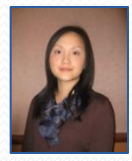


## Testimonies of WHAW Coordinators

Qhov uas kuv kam ua ib tus pab rau cov coj nkauj no mas yog vim kuv tau thov Vajtswv tias kuv yuav xyaum mloog Vajstvw lus thiab xyaum ua li nws qhia. Thaum thawj niam tsev hu tuaj rau kuv mas kuv kuj xyeej thiab tiamsi kuv kuj tau hais rau nws tias kuv mam li ua. Vim kuv tau hais rau Vajtswv lawm tias yam tws uas nws pom zoo rau kuv ua no ces kuv yuav zoo siab thiab yuav ua kom kawg kuv lub peev xwm uas nws pub rau kuv muaj. Txawm tias kuv tsis txawj los kuv ntseeg hais tias Vajtswv yeej yuav pab kom kuv ua tau.

### Health Recommendations:

Staying healthy is essential for everyone. We need to be healthy physically and spiritually to fulfill God's will and to help others. Recommendation to staying healthy this year is to see your family doctor about health screenings.

Dr. Ia Kue, at Lifetime Family Care, would like to encourage our women to get a baseline screening for general health as a good way to start off the new year. Talk and ask your family doctor for further information on health screenings. Here are some important screening Dr. Ia recommends:

- Cholesterol/diabetes/HTN:  
Important because these are risk factors that lead to heart disease and kidney failure, and is becoming more prevalent with the Hmong Americans.
- Hepatitis B screening:  
Important because this is so common with the Hmong and among Asians.
- Cervical cancer screening:  
Screened yearly after age 21.
- Breast cancer screening:  
Screened yearly after age 40.
- Colon cancer screening:  
Screened starting at age 50.
